Introductions & Welcome

Chief Páez welcomed the members.

Approval of October 17, 2025, Minutes

Chief Zambito motioned to approve the minutes from January 23, 2026; Second: Chief Weiner, motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

- Mr. Rubino provided a brief overview of the financial report, which he noted was dated through April 15, to include the member fees and Motorola maintenance expense. He advised that account activity for the year was in line with expectations.

Technical Committee Report

- Mr. Kris Harris advised that during the windstorm on March 13, power was lost to the Hard Rd. tower site. The site is the only one without a generator. The UPS lasts for approximately two hours. Power was out for 24 hours. Sellers Electric will provide a quote for a cam lock connection at the site so a generator can be easily connected in the event of power loss. Mr. Harris recommends a cam lock hookup rather than a permanent generator installation due to the space available on the lot, the site's location, and the lack of need for a permanent generator.
- Mr. Chris Waldo noted that the Virtual Prime cutover for Delaware on June 24 should not have an effect on Dublin because it will not affect the master site.
- Mr. Waldo discussed the fiber move at the Prime Site. He advised that the conduit path was run on Tuesday. During the cutover, Dublin will need to use backup radios. Mr. Waldo said he will turn off roaming. No date has been set for the cutover. When the cutover occurs, it will take however long is required to splice the fiber together.
